

## PROFILE OF MEC SEBONTA DESBO MOHONO



Sebonta Desbo Mohono was born in 28 October 1970 in Chaneng Village near Rustenburg. She schooled at Chaneng Primary School and continued her studies at Mafenya Middle School until she completed her studies at Seabe High School in Mpumalanga Province. She obtained her Diploma in Education from Lehurutshe College of Education in 1993, she started teaching at Rakoko High School for a period of ten years, she continued with her teaching career at Rauwane Sepeng in Tlhabane for another five years.

In 2009 Desbo Mohono became a Member of Provincial Legislature in the North West Provincial Legislature, subsequent to that she was appointed as a Member of Executive Council.

## GOVERNMENT

Desbo Mohono is currently the MEC for the Department of Tourism in the North West Province. MEC Mohono had a mammoth task of establishing Tourism Department as previously was just a directorate in the bigger picture, but with her diligence, tenacity and commitment, she led and develop the department very well.

In 2009 she was deployed as MEC responsible for the Department of Human Settlement and Public Safety & Liaison and in 2012 she was then appointed MEC for the Department of Agriculture and Rural Development. MEC Mohono created an opportunity for project owners in Agriculture to market their products. Farming communities will remember her about the mark that she has made in the latter department.

Her achievements were and are felt all over South Africa especially in the province. She established a vegetable market for Taung and Mahikeng where farmers can sell their vegetables, eggs, food and sheep just to mention a few from their agricultural projects.

She encouraged the partnership between the department and Industrial Development Corporation (IDC) to empower farmers who met the requirements to acquire the Nguni cattle. She gave the opportunity to rural communal farmers to breed and multiply the cows they received from government and we believe she will be missed for her good deeds especially in rural areas.

She negotiated with Royal Bafokeng Platinum Mines to contribute to Taung Agriculture Irrigation Scheme and the mine contributed a sum of R1 million only towards the irrigation in Taung as part of their Corporate Social Responsibility.
