- (a) Applications must be accompanied by signed Z83, a recent updated comprehensive CV with names of three referees; originally certified copies of Grade 12, ID-document, required Driving License, Security Clearance from SAPS. **Failure to submit the requested documents will result in the application not being considered.**
- (b) All qualifications will be verified. Persons in possession of a foreign qualification must furnish this Department with an evaluation certificate from the South African Qualification Authority (SAQA).
