## Official launch of 2016 October Transport Month Campaign

The Minister of Transport, Ms. Dipuo Peters, will officially launch the 2016 October Transport Month campaign on Saturday, 1<sup>st</sup> October 2016 in Mmorogong village, near Tlhatlhaganyane in the Moses Kotane Local Municipality, North West Province under the theme: ***“Together we move South Africa Forward.”***

This month-long programme will showcase transport infrastructure projects, promote the use of public transport and advance the country’s road safety initiatives.

Minister Peters will be joined by Transport Deputy Minister, Ms Sindisiwe Chikunga and the hosts North West MECs for Community Safety and Transport Management Dr. M.N. Motlhabane and the MEC for Public Works and Roads, Mr. Madoda Sambatha. MECs from other provinces, Bojanala Platinum District Municipality and Moses Kotane Local Municipality leadership and transport stakeholders will also attend.

The principals will launch Transport Month by officially opening and handing over Provincial Road P54/1 between Matooster and Ruighoek to the communities of Mmorogong and Tlhatlhaganyane. Approximately 31km long, the road was in a severely deteriorating condition and has now been rehabilitated. P54/1 is an important economic regional distributor that links Rustenburg and the Pilanesberg area via Ledig, Matooster and Ruighoek and will also link communities of these areas.
