Forth of 10-point campaign plan set to clean corruption, crime and defaulting motorists in Bokone Bophirima

Defaulting motorists in and around Brits area felt the pinch of the law when the Provincial Traffic Authorities implemented the forth point of the Premier's ten-point campaign, which is set to ensure Safety, Security, Comfort, Corruption and crime free society.

The forth campaign which began with creating safety on the Brits roads by ensuring that all vehicles are roadworthy, was part of the official launch of the Ten-Point Campaign Plan that was recently held at the Madibeng Sports Ground.

More than 23 vehicles were impounded by traffic authorities for different offences such as driving without driver's license, PRDP, unroadworthy vehicles, expired disc and wrong routes with the monetary value of R61 300.

MEC for Community Safety and Transport Management, Dr Mpho Motlhabane said his Department is committed in implementing its forth Point in ensuring the smooth running of Premier call.

"Our point of departure from this launch is that we are going to consolidate the plan on how are we going to approach this campaign as the Department. The plan will obviously cover the road traffic management which has already set the tone during the launch by impounding vehicles that are not roadworthy, will also include our intensified road safety education, crime prevention and all those that are part of responsibilities as outlined on the NDP," said Motlhabane.

The departmental MEC outlined that the plan will be linked with the Setsokotsane programme, which is currently implemented in all four districts of the province.

The launch of the 10 point campaign plan came as an announcement by Premier Supra Mahumapelo during this year.

This social mobilisation campaign plan is aligned to Setsokotsane, Reconciliation, Healing and Renewal to deal with societal issues affecting people on a daily basis. The plan is further set to ensure that the maximum impact of government's presence is created within the context of Setsokotsane.
