N14 closed with rocks and burning tyres - motorists cautioned

Motorists travelling on the N14 between Delareyville and Vryburg are cautioned and requested to be vigilant following the road closure due to the protest march of Botselo Milling employees who have since been on an illegal strike for weeks.

The protesters have barricaded the road with rocks, burning tyres and also throwing stones and dangerous objects to by-passing traffic.

Police and Traffic officers are monitoring the scene and redirecting road users to alternative routes. Motorists are therefore requested to cooperate.

Community Safety and Transport Management MEC Gaoage Molapisi urged motorists to cooperate with traffic authorities when directed to take alternative roads.

At some point our officers will redirect you to the road that might be costly and long for you to reach your destination but it is for your own safety and it is our responsibility as the department to make sure that you reach your destinations safely, please cooperate and comply, +he pleaded.
