### **MEC MOTLHABANE TO LEAD A MARCH AGAINST SEXUAL OFFENSES ON ELDERLY**

MEC for Department of Community Safety and Transport Management , Dr Mokgantsang “Mpho” Motlhabane will lead the march that is intended to "reclaim the streets" in the fight against crime, focusing on sexual offenses particularly on elderly, vulnerable and young people. The march will be part of the official launch of the Safety and Security Month that is scheduled to take place at Boitekong Extension 23, in the Rustenburg Local Municipality on Friday, 03 February 2017.

The initiative is aimed at fighting against crime which coincide with the Ten Point Plan articulated by the Premier of Bokone Bophirima, to promote safety, security, comfort, corruption and crime free society.
