### **Motorists to renew their vehicle licenses in Klerksdorp post office**

Motorists in the KOSH area in the Matlosana Local Municipality can now renew their vehicle licenses at the Klerksdorp post office. This was confirmed by the North West MEC for



Human Settlements, Public Safety and Liaison on Friday after he officially opened the Post Office Licensing Authority.

MEC Maloyi said the department remains confident that its partnership with the South African Post Office will greatly support the government to achieve its objective of accessible service delivery in

particular bringing services closer to the people as envisaged by the constitution.
