Premier Mokgoro offers condolences to the Duma family

Mahikeng – North West Premier, Professor Tebogo Job Mokgoro has expressed his heartfelt condolences to the Duma family on the demise of Ndleleni Moses Duma who passed away today at the age of 60, after a long illness.

Sending his message of condolences to the bereaved family, Premier Mokgoro said the late Ndleleni Duma was a selfless and resilient leader who served the North West province with diligence and great distinction.

“I wish to, on behalf of the people of the province, send our deepest condolences to the Duma family and friends during this difficult time. As we mourn this remarkable man’s untimely death, we must also celebrate his extraordinary life, which he devoted towards changing the lives of ordinary citizens of the province” said Premier Mokgoro, adding that Duma will always be remembered with gratitude, for the contribution he made in deepening democracy and building solid grounds for development of the people he served.

Ndleleni Duma served the provincial government in different capacities including as a Member of Executive Council responsible for Agriculture between 2004 and 2006, and Sport, Arts and Culture between 2006 and 2009. He was later deployed to the National Assembly where he was a Member of Parliament from 2009 to 2014. At the time of his passing, Duma was a member of the North West Provincial Legislature.

Premier Mokgoro described him as a courageous leader who inspired many. Premier is expected to visit the bereaved family in Potchefstroom tomorrow, Saturday, 24 November, at 10h00.
