**SABC In Partnership With Human Settlements North West Handover Houses In Mantja Village**

North West MEC for Human Settlements, Public Safety and Liaison, Nono Maloyi in partnership with the SABC North West will officially handover three houses as part of a special housing project to a family of twenty five (25) in Mantja village outside Mahikeng.

The family's plight was made public through the SABC news' "Touching Lives" segment. The corporation in partnership with the department as well as other key stakeholders embarked on a Corporate Social Investment (CSI) campaign to build shelter for the family.

The family headed by 63 year old partially blind Mosekeng Mosiane resides in a two roomed make-shift shack which was built in 2008 and has no form of income to sustain them.
