### **Developers get tongue lashing for non-performance**

The Department of Local Government and Human Settlements in Bokone Bophirima, yesterday resumed its engagement sessions with underperforming housing developers in the province in an effort to get them to commit to their delivery schedules accelerating delivery.

Addressing the developers yesterday in Taung, Head of Department, Pihadu Motoko, called for accelerated delivery in the upcoming months in order to lessen the chances of the department losing its housing development grant. 'All of you have signed performance contracts with clear time frames but you have failed dismally to deliver in line with the contract. Your non-performance is an indictment on us and we can no longer allow the situation to continue", said Motoko.

Motoko had earlier in the day, visited incomplete housing projects in Taung and nearby villages.
