### MEC Rosho meets with housing developers in Mahikeng

**Mahikeng-** The North West MEC for Local Government and Human Settlements, Motlalepula Rosho, yesterday held a meeting with housing developers of Ngaka Modiri Molema district to assess their current performance in housing delivery.

The meeting provided the department with an opportunity to interact with the housing developers in order to get to understand their challenges. One of the issues that was raised, was the water shortage in the district.

MEC Rosho said, "although the district performance is not where it is supposed to be, the results in relation to the expenditure are starting to show some improvement. A lot still has to be done for the department to achieve its target for the current financial year. This district has a number of emerging contractors who do not have the required capacity in terms of financial, technical and project which caused delay in service delivery. As for the water challenge, there are sessions that are on-going to address the issues", she said.

She added that a war room has been established to resolve the water challenge which is a serious problem for the entire province, especially in Ngaka Modiri Molema and Dr Ruth Segomotsi district municipalities," said MEC Rosho.

She also appealed to housing developers who are building houses for Military Veterans need to prioritise them as part of priorities on issues of development. She committed the department to continue supporting developers in their work.
