The first three weeks of school couldn't be more pleasant for the learners of Matloding primary school when MEC for Local Government and Human Settlements, Galaletsang Gaolaolwe who was accompanied by the Mayor of Ratlou local municipality, Tebogo Modise to handover school shoes and piles of sanitary pads to needy pupils, last week.

The donation was propelled by a promise she made late last year after seeing many pupils without proper school shoes subsequent to a call to assist with sanitary towels when she attended the sewer spillage matter in the village.

We acknowledge that coming from impoverished background can deter learner's focus from their studies, from routinely sleeping on an empty stomach to being constantly ridiculed for your worn out school shoes is also discouraging", she said.
