#### **MEC Maine calls for order in Ramotshere Moiloa**

Zeerust - MEC for Local Government and Human Settlements in Bokone Bophirima, Collen Maine has on Tuesday called for calm and restrain for workers to refrain from denying the community of Ramotshere Moiloa local municipality much needed services, following the disruption of municipal services in the past weeks. MEC Maine has also called on the councillors to fully support the newly elected Mayor Simon Senna, following a recent special council meeting.

For more than two weeks, service delivery has seriously been compromised in the municipality after councillors convened a special council meeting and passed a motion of no confidence against the then Mayor, Councillor Africa Thale. MEC Maine said the report he has received thus far from the municipality indicated that all processes to elect the new Mayor, were properly followed to the last details.

MEC Maine further condemned the conduct of the Speaker of Ramotshere Moiloa, Thwesa after he failed to call a special council meeting at the behest of the MEC.
