N14 MIXED INTERGRATED DEVELOPMENT SET TO BENEFIT COMMUNITY OF VENTERSDORP

Mahikeng- In his state of the province address, Premier Prof Job Mokgoro made an announcement that residents of Tshing in Ventersdorp poor services will soon be a thing of the past making reference to the N14 project. “The end of this financial year heralds the beginning of the new era for the community of Ventersdorp with the implementation of a mega project commonly known as the N14 project” said the Premier. The mega project is intended to provide services to the community and also to revitalise the area through building new settlements in line with the Spatial Plan and the NDP vision 2030.

Premier Mokgoro charged that, the North West Province can no longer afford to return allocated budget (grants) while people continue to be homeless, the development of this mega project will go a long way in alleviating poverty through the creation of temporary and permanent jobs as this includes the development of a mall through private funding and create over three thousand (3000) mixed housing opportunities including bonded houses, social housing and breaking new ground commonly known as RDP's.

The construction of additional bulk sewer in the area of Ventersdorp will also assist in enhancing the current provision services for in general as well as the supply of water and electricity through water reservoir and electricity sub stations.

The department of Local Government and Human Settlements is one of the departments that has been directed to audit all its existing settlements in the province and to check whether they have all been declared in terms of the Municipal Planning Tribunal requirements.
