NORTH WEST PUBLIC WORKS MEC YAWA EMBARKS ON DEPARTMENTAL ROADSHOW

The MEC for Public Works in the North West Province, the Honourable Howard Yawa, MPL embarks on a week long departmental road show to engage public servants in the Provincial Department of Public Works on the implementation of the People's Contract, and the Expanded Public Works Programme as well as to acquaint himself with the challenges of service delivery at the level closest to the people.

On Thursday the 15th, after meeting with Regional Management (8H30-10H00), MEC Yawa is confirmed to address four hundred public servants from the Central Region of the Province at the Mmabatho Civic Centre, Mmabatho (10H30-12H00) and visit construction sites (14H00-15H30).

Following the same programme and time allocations throughout the road show, the entire Executive Management of the Department led by the Provincial Head of the Department, Dr. Lydia Sebego is expected to also be part of the meeting including those to be held in other regions as follows:
