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MEC YAWA DEMANDS ACCOUNTABILITY FROM CONSULTANTS

MEC Yawa said, "We expect consultants to guide and support contractors and to cope with our demand for accountability and prompt delivery. We expect nothing less than delivery of projects within shorter time frames, on budget and to a higher standard of quality."

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
