MEC YAWA TURNS SOD FOR R18, 3 MILION PROJECT

North West MEC for Public Works, Honourable Howard Yawa today turned the sod for the commencement of an R18, 3million Project in Jouberton outside of Matlosana City.

The Secure Care Centre for youth in conflict with the law consists of a Youth Court, Workshops for rehabilitation, Computer room, Administration Block, a clinic and an on site Police Station.

On completion, the facility will cater for 60 Youths, i.e. 40 males and 20 females and alleviate juvenile overcrowding in prisons.

Speaking at the function, MEC Yawa urged the community to support the Joint Venture awarded the contract so that the project is completed within the 10 months contract period.

Co-officiating at the same function, MEC for Social Development, Honourable Nikiwe Mangqo said the centre presents hope for rehabilitation of youth in an environment that supports their development.
