## NORTH WEST HONOUR MINISTER SIGCAU

The North West Province today celebrated the life and contribution of the late Minister Stella Sigcau towards rural development and transformation of the construction and properties sectors at a Memorial Service held in her honour at the Mmabatho Convention Centre in the North West Provincial capital of Mafikeng.
