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**MEC Mohono visits schools in the Bojanala District**

these schools and also that our district offices are receiving the necessary support in

order to realize our set goals in education", she said

education is giving these schools here in Bojanala, even though there are

schools namely Charora Secondary School and Bonwakgogo Primary School in her

home village of Chaneng where she was joined by the Provincial Deputy Speaker
