### **MEC Mokua declares North West Province a construction site...**

"Speaking of transparency, it must be noted that despite the budget cuts, we are determined to deliver more with the less that we have and that we will not compromise service delivery. My appeal to the members of the community is for them to work together with the department and contractors by not disrupting project. We will avail ourselves for engagements where there are disputes. Let us work together in developing our province", she said.
