MEC YAWA TO HANDOVER PRIMARY SCHOOL IN KAGUNG VILLAGE

North West MEC for Public Works, Honourable Mr. Howard Yawa is to handover a newly built A. D. Kolwane Primary School to the MEC for Education on Friday 13 May 2005 in Kagung Village near Kuruman.

The Primary school Project built at a cost of R4, 7 million is to serve the 8000 rural community of Kagung village and reduce overcrowding at Vlakfontein Primary School.

The community through a democratic and participatory process has named the school after the late Councillor A.D. Kolwane who died tragically in a car accident in December 2003. The naming of the school is in recognition of the instrumental role that the late Councillor played towards the initiation of the Project and development in the area.

A Tour of the facility for the invited guests and media follows the short handover programme that is scheduled to commence at 12H00.
