3	Certified copy of ID Document (student);
4	Certified copy of Statement of Matric results (current matriculants). NB: Matric Certificate is compulsory for all applicants
5	Certified copy of End of year results /last academic results (Students already at tertiary)
6	Certified copy of acceptance letter from institution of higher learning.
7	ATTACH PROOF OF PARENT/S & GUARDIAN/S INCOME DOCUMENT/S: SALARY PAY SLIP/S (NB. In case of Deceased or unemployed parent/s attach copy of Death Certificate/s/ affidavit).
