MEC YAWA TO ENGAGE PUBLIC WORKS EMPLOYEES IN REGIONS

As he kick-starts his weeklong departmental road show throughout the four regions in the North West Province, the MEC for Public Works, Honourable Howard Yawa, MPL is to address tomorrow, Thursday 15 July 2004 four hundred public works employees at the Mmabatho Civic Centre (10H30-12H00) after meeting with the Regional Management for the Central Region (8H30-10H00).

After the meeting with employees, the MEC's entourage proceeds to onsite Projects briefings at three primary schools in Lomanyaneng Village, i.e. Mokgwetsi Primary School, Lomanyaneng Primary School and Mosiane Primary School and Ramatlabama Traditional Offices in Ramatlabama Village

The MEC is to engage public works employees on the implementation of the People's Contract, and the Expanded Public Works Programme as well as to acquaint himself with the challenges of service delivery at the level closest to the people.
