#### CONSTRUCTION SECTOR BBBEE CHARTER PROCESS IN-PUTS

The Department of Public Works in the North West is availing ahead of the Construction Sector Broad Based Black Economic Empowerment National Indaba to be held as from 19-21 April 2005, copies of the Construction Sector Broad Based Black Economic Empowerment Draft Charter for in-puts by stakeholders in the Construction Sector.

As per resolution of the Provincial Workshop held on 17 February 2005, copies of the Draft Transformation Charter to be distributed on a first come first served basis will be available at all Regional Offices of the North West Department of Public Works as from Monday 21 March 2005.

North West Public Works MEC Mr. Howard Yawa urges all stakeholders involved in the construction sector to make in-puts and contribute towards a transformed construction industry.

The charter provides a framework for the construction sector to enhance capacity and grow whilst addressing Black Economic Empowerment and transformation. It aims amongst others to achieve a substantial change in the racial and gender composition of ownership, control and management, and in specialised professions in the sector.
